Pandas Are Coming to NYC - Art Exhibition

May 19, 2016. The **Chinese Cultural Foundation** in conjunction with the **China Investment Group** held an "Pandas Are Coming to NYC - Art Exhibition" and honored the talented 18 years old young Chinese artist, **Xuanjin Wang**, with its Young Artists Award. The occasion celebrated an exciting new initiative - a project to bring two Giant Panda cubs from China to New York City.
